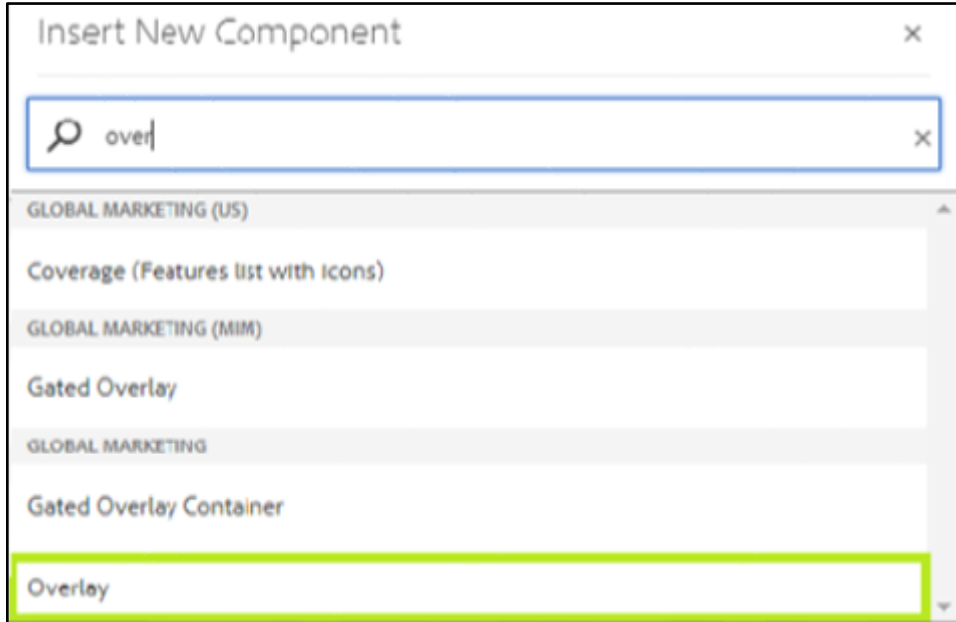

#### Configuration:

- 1) **Overlay Trigger Button Text** – Provide unique text
- 2) **Enable close behavior For Transparent Background** – check/uncheck the close behavior
- 3) **Text Content** – Provide meaningful text.
- 4) **Button Variation Type** – Must select the option from the drop down one button- primary, Two button primary/secondary, one button w/ text link and two button w/ text link
- 5) **Primary Button Text**– Must provide meaningful text.
- 6) **Enable close behavior For Primary Button** – check/uncheck the close behavior
- 7) **secondary Button Text**– Must provide meaningful text.
- 8) **Enable close behavior For secondary Button** – check/uncheck the close behavior
