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4 Component Dialog

- Select edit to open the dialog and begin editing the component fields.

Feature Overview

Configuration

1. **Component ID** – Provide a unique ID for the component without any spaces.
2. **Divider Height** – Provide the height dimension for the divider. The default value is 4px.
3. **Divider Color** – Select the dropdown value either as '**Gradient**', '**Grey**' or '**Black**'.
4. **Copy** – Provide a meaningful text which indicates the title of new section.
5. **Custom Margin Top** – Provide the margin top for the Divider. By providing a value here will override the default margin.
6. **Custom Margin Bottom** – Provide the margin bottom for the Divider. By providing a value here will override the default margin.
