Feature Overview

Report Headline and Title

Used to highlight and describe Reports.

Following rules are enforced:

- On Click both Headline and Title navigate Users to the report

CTA

Used as Text link to Report

Following recommendations are provided to the Author:

- On Click navigates User to the Report

Desktop

- Category Copies (on Desktop - On hover, show Category in ‘active state’, show category, headline and BG image corresponding to the Category)

Tablet & Mobile

- Category Copies (on Mobile/Tablet - Tap/Swipe on Category copy -show Category in active state’, show category, headline and BG image corresponding to the Category)

Breakpoint Considerations

On mobile:

- Elements stack vertically

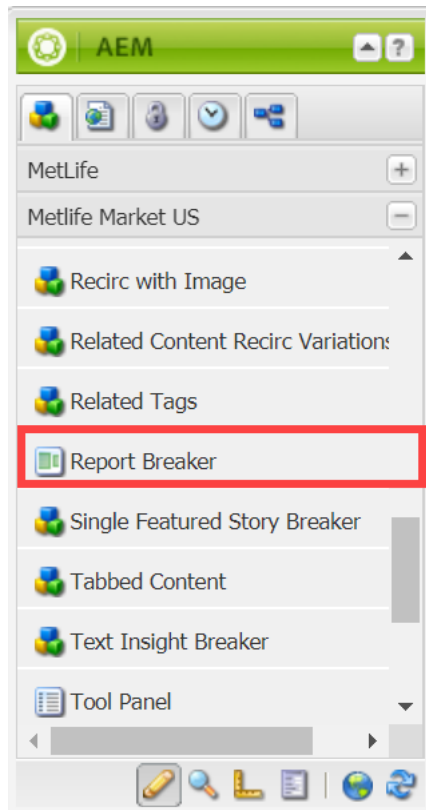

- Open in - Option to open Category when clicked on in Same page or New page
