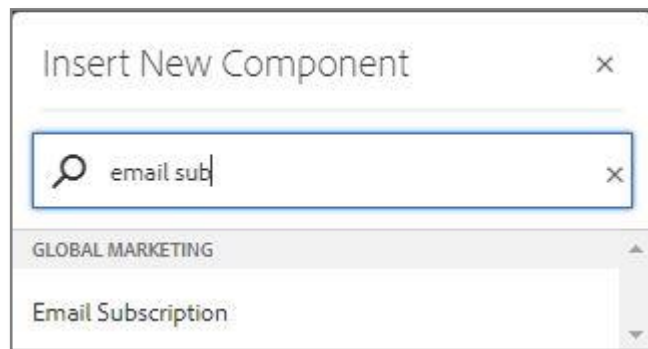

- Select configure option to open the dialog and begin editing the component fields.



### Configuration


- 1) **Component ID** – Must unique component ID.
- 2) **Title** – Must provide meaningful text.
- 3) **Eyebrow** – Must provide meaningful text.
- 4) **AEM form path** – Must provide path for the AEM form.
- 5) **Outline** – Must select an option from the dropdown.
- 6) **Width** – Must select an option from the dropdown.

There are two variations for this component.

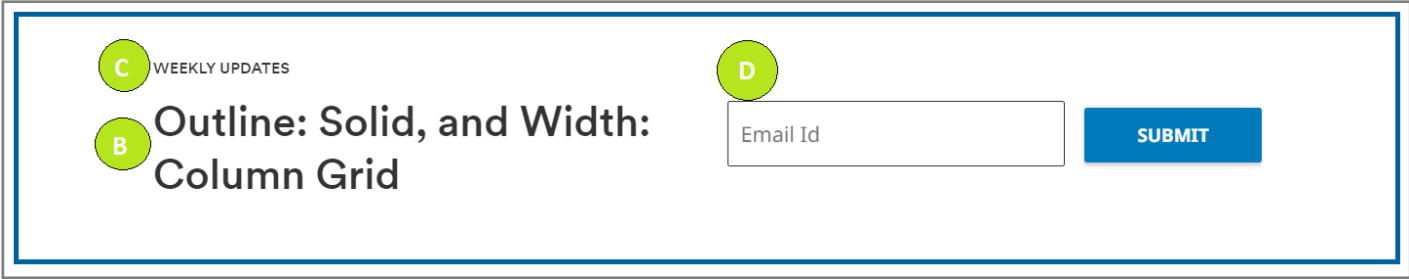
**Variation 1: Email Subscription with Outline as Solid, and width as Column Grid.**
